Job Overview: The Maintenance Technician/Operator is responsible for operation and preventive maintenance for wastewater treatment plant, wells, mechanical equipment and building structures, standby generators and outside telephone lines for all facilities that CB&I is responsible for.

Key Responsibilities/Accountabilities:

- Position will hold responsibility for performing technical work in maintaining, repairing and upkeep of wastewater collection lift stations, water wells and water and wastewater facilities, including building structures.
- This position is responsible for maintenance and minor repairs to water and wastewater equipment.
- This position will hold the responsibility for maintaining outside telephone lines and providing operator maintenance on several standby generators.
- Additionally, this position will act as a water distribution and wastewater treatment operator as a secondary function.
- Performs operator functions at wastewater treatment plant and at water wells. Performs scheduled and emergency repairs and maintenance of all wastewater plant equipment, lift stations and associated equipment in water distribution, wastewater treatment, and wastewater collection facilities. Locate and maintain outside telephone lines.
- Performs preventive maintenance and services program lift station buildings, grounds and machinery by using a variety of hand tools and power tools in semiskilled work.
- Perform operator maintenance on generators.
- Must be able to operate trucks and high-pressure water cleaning equipment.
- Maintains daily operational and maintenance logs and records for water and wastewater facilities.
- Repair or replace water lines and sewer collection lines.
- Repair or replace pumps, motors, control panels and/or a variety of electrical components.
- Read plans, maps, and schematics related to water and wastewater.
- Perform all routine maintenance on equipment, such as lubrication, oil changes, and belt changes. Perform routine repair work, such as disassembly, repair, and installation of ball valves, switches and related equipment.
- Perform all work in accordance with local, state, and federal laws, rules, and regulations and in compliance with all departmental safety policies and procedures. This includes using appropriate safety devices and equipment.
- May be required in emergency situations to report to work during unscheduled time.
- To the extent of ability, use a variety of hand tools, such as saws, drills, wrenches, shovels, etc., and power tools, such as, drill and bench presses, grinders, drills, and a variety of saws, including electric, chain, reciprocating, table, and jigsaw. Specialized equipment, such as electrical test equipment, may be used under close to limited supervision depending on the area where equipment is used and potential risk involved.

Basic Qualifications:

- High School Diploma Required
- Minimum of 3 years' experience
- Must have Louisiana Class 2 Wastewater Operator License. Persons who also have Louisiana Class 2 Water Operator License preferred.
- Must possess a valid State driver's license.
- Must be able to apply basic knowledge of water and wastewater treatment to the existing systems, equipment, and facilities.
- Must have a strong basic knowledge of mechanical, electrical, pneumatic, and hydraulic theory and application, and be able to use manuals and other resources to apply that knowledge in water and wastewater treatment operations and other diverse requirements of the job.
- Physical strength and ability sufficient to perform heavy manual labor for extended periods under wet, cold, and generally unpleasant conditions.
- Physical stamina and agility sufficient to stand, walk, climb stairs, crawl and bend and engage in similar physical activities for the duration of the shift, as necessary.
- Capacity for sustained attention to functioning machinery and equipment. Good sensory perception to monitor plant machinery and operations visually, audibly, by smell, and by touch (for temperature and vibration) on an ongoing basis.
- Ability to wear all required safety and protective gear and equipment.
- Basic knowledge and ability to read equipment instruction and maintenance manuals, drawings, schematics, and blueprints.
- Good working knowledge of math and chemistry and the specific applications of these in the plant and laboratory.
- Ability to make rapid and sound decisions in the event of extraordinary situations such as equipment malfunctions or power outages to protect public health and equipment. Frequently required to exercise this judgment while unsupervised.

Other Details:

- The nature of this position requires this person to be subject to call 24 hours per day on a rotating basis including weekends and holidays.
- Depending on the task being performed, the environment may be a wet, muddy, dark, cold, subject to hot, noisy, wet, or slippery conditions. Much of the work is performed outside in all kinds of weather conditions. This work can be unusually stressful due to need to make quick decisions to avoid equipment damage or dangerous results.
- Individuals may perform other duties as assigned, including work in other functional areas to cover absences or relief, to equalize peak work periods or otherwise to balance the workload
