II. GENERAL SUMMARY:

This is a full-time, 40 hour/week position. Job will require employee to work overtime during scheduled tournaments and/or if requested by Park Superintendent for emergency repairs. It requires the employee to have the ability to handle all the listed duties and responsibilities and possess experience/knowledge required for this position. It also requires the listed physical abilities.

III. PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **Water wells:** The Infrastructure Specialist is responsible for ensuring that the parks water system is in state compliance at all times, performing the daily sampling of the water systems total and free chlorine levels, as well as maintaining all documentation in regards to sampling. Monitors and adjust chlorine levels as needed to stay within permit requirements. Ordering all supplies needed for the operation of the water system. (1 – 1,000 gallon water tank and 1 – 12,000 gallon tank) Ensuring proper signage is displayed at all well heads and chlorinators. Working with D.H.H. on sampling at sites monthly. Maintaining all permits and licensing required in the production, treatment, and distribution of facility water.
- **Sewer plants:** The Infrastructure Specialist is responsible for ensuring that the parks sewer system (1 – 2,500 gallon and 1 – 5,000 gallon package plants) is in state compliance at all times, performing daily inspections of plants, performing required maintenance on all pumps and blower motors as well as maintaining all documentation in regards to permit levels. Monitors and adjust chlorine tablet disinfection as needed to stay within permit requirements. Ordering all supplies needed for the operation of the sewer system. Ensuring proper signage is displayed at both sewer plants and 11 lift stations. Working with D.H.H and D.E.Q. on sampling at sites. Maintaining all permits, DMRS and licensing required in the collection and treatment, of facilities.
- **Roadways, parking lots, drainage:** The Infrastructure Specialist is responsible for maintaining all of the parks roadways, parking lots, pathways, drainage, road and parking lot lighting, bridges, culverts, and signage. To include making small cold patch and liquid hot patch repairs to roads and lots, restriping parking lots, curbs, repainting roadway gates, guard rails, bollards. Repairing bridges, cleaning drains and catch basins of debris after rains, Cleaning and/or replacing roadway and parking lot signage.

Future projects and improvements

- The Infrastructure Specialist will work with Park Superintendent and Director to develop a timeline for repair projects needed in the Park, as well as a list of future infrastructure projects.

Other Duties may include

- Duties will also include some computer skills, ability to file, record keeping, and maintain their own office, written and verbal correspondence. Job duties may include additional items as assigned by the Director not outlined in this job description.
- Oversee /perform daily infrastructure repairs if needed in a timely manner while still providing quality work as well as a safe environment.
- Operation of all park equipment for construction and/or repairs.
- Complete check sheets, record and maintain detailed records of all repair projects, completing and turning in all repair work sheets.

IV. KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Must possess at least a Class 1 water certification in production, treatment, and distribution. A Class 1 sewer collection and treatment would be a plus, but not mandatory.
- Must be able to read blueprints; electrical schematics, mechanical, structural, etc. and be able to understand specifications.
- Must be able to learn and understand construction as well as ADA, and State codes and permits guidelines.
- Must have good verbal, writing, and computer skills.
- Knowledge and ability to work on basic carpentry, plumbing, electrical and painting. Ability to operate large equipment such as a bobcat excavator, tractor, front end loader etc. as well as all forms and types of carpentry and plumbing tools
- Knowing and adhering to all park policies and procedures on a daily basis.
- Maintain a positive attitude toward fellow Supervisors, and fellow co-workers while at work, a team player.
- Commitment to make it to work, not abusing absenteeism or tardiness.
- Setting an example by taking the extra steps to ensure that every task performed is to the very best of the individual's ability.
- Ensuring that employees are following policy & procedures.
- Ability to communicate with all levels of staff / employees within the Recreation District
- Ability to respond during stressful conditions when working within strict and sometimes unexpected deadlines.

VI. PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- This position can involve heavy manual labor.
- Must undergo a pre-employment physical and drug screening.
- Subject to random drug testing in the event of an accident or incident.
- Ability to lift 50 pounds or more.
- Must physically be able to bend, twist, kneel, squat, push, pull, lift, carry, and hold possible large and/or heavy objects.
