- Shall be available to work additional time during emergency situations
- Any other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School diploma or General Equivalency Degree (GED)
- A minimum of two (2) years of experience in the water field
- Be able to pass water certification exams and become certified within the first two (2) years of employment
- Shall have the ability to read and interpret documents, safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, procedure manuals, etc.
